

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy governs the manner in which Sequence of Events Ltd. collects, uses, maintains and discloses information collected from users of the websites owned or controlled by Sequence of Events Ltd., including:

This privacy policy also applies to all products and services offered by Sequence of Events Ltd.

At Sequence of Events Ltd. we take privacy very seriously and are committed to protecting personal information. This privacy policy explains how we may collect and use the information a person provides us.

Terminology

For the purpose of this privacy policy, the term “person” or “persons” is used to refer to

- Users of the websites listed above
- Persons utilising products and services offered by Sequence of Events Ltd.
- Any persons in contact with Sequence of Events Ltd. in person and/or by phone, by email, by any online/electronic means.

Consent

Personal consent

By providing personal information, a person consents to us collecting and using that information in the ways that described in this privacy policy and/or that the person has specifically consented to.

Marketing consent

We will only send marketing information by email or phone if a person has given us specific consent to do so. If a person withdraws their consent and then subsequently opts in, then the most recent preference may supersede.

How We Collect Information

We may collect personal identification information from persons in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to:

- When a person visits any of the sites listed above
- When a person enquires about our services
- When a person places an order/makes a purchase
- When a person signs up to receive updates on our work or events
- When a person applies for or enquires about a job
- When a person attends a meeting with us and provides us with information about themselves
- When a person takes part in one of our events
- When a person contacts us through the following channels: online, email, phone, social media, post or in person

Where We Collect Information

Direct

When a person gives us information directly, they may provide the information to us when they request specific information or participate in one of our events.

Indirect

A persons' information may be shared with us indirectly when they register for one of our events via BookingLive. BookingLive will have their own privacy policy and/or privacy statements. We advise that persons understand these policies when providing their data.

Employer/Colleague

When a persons' employer or colleague passes a persons' details on to us we will clarify what said person has are consented to in terms of communication.

Other Organisations

When a person has given other organisations permission to share it: a person may have provided their details to another organisation that works with Sequence of Events Ltd. However, when working with other organisations, we work to ensure it's completely clear that a persons' information will be shared with Sequence of Events Ltd. The information we get from these services depends on the persons' settings or the response choices a person provides. It is advised that a person regularly checks what they have agreed to with third party organisations.

Websites Owned or Controlled by Sequence of Events Ltd.

When we collect information when a person uses one of our websites: Upon visiting our website, information about a persons' visit may be recorded and stored.

Other Public Sources

We may collect personal details available from other public sources such as social networks, company websites, and news archives.

Web browser cookies

Our Site may use "cookies" to enhance a persons' experience. A person's web browser places cookies on their hard drive for record-keeping purposes and sometimes to track information about them. A person may choose to set their web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert when cookies are being sent. If they do so, note that some parts of the websites owned or controlled by Sequence of Events Ltd. may not function properly.

Categories of Personal Information We May Collect

The type and quantity of information we collect and how we use it depends on why a person is providing it.

A person may be asked for, as appropriate:

- Name
- Email address
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Credit/debit card information
- Special/dietary requirements

A person may, however, visit our websites anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from persons only if they voluntarily submit such information to us. A person can always refuse to supply personally identification information, except that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website related activities.

If a person were to visit our websites anonymously, we may still record information about:

- the areas of the website visited
- the amount of time spent on the site
- whether a person is new to the site, or have visited before

- how a person came to our website
- the type of computer, browser, network location and internet connection used

How We Use Collected Information

Sequence of Events Ltd. may collect and use a persons' personal information for the following purposes:

- To provide services or information a person has requested
- To update a person about any changes to our services
- For organisational records and ensure we have a person's most up-to-date marketing preferences
- To help us improve our services, campaigns or information-offering
- To pursue debts or unpaid fees
- To analyse and improve the operation of our website
- To analyse a persons' website behaviour

We endeavour to make all reasonable efforts to keep a persons' details secure and only share them with external companies working on our behalf. We rely on a set of external companies to provide us with services that enable our business to run properly. Our core service providers include:

- WordPress
- BookingLive (event registration software)
- SagePay (to process online payments)
- WorldPay (payment provider)
- Event Venues (to supply attendee lists or dietary/special requirements)

These organisations will have their own privacy policy and/or privacy statements, so it is advised that persons ensure an understanding of this when providing their data.

We do not sell, trade, or rent a person's personal identification information to others.

Except as required by law, we will never share a persons' details with other organisations to use for their own purposes.

How Long Information is Stored

We will hold personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity, for example we will keep a record of any payments made for at least six years.

If a person asks us to stop sending marketing materials, we will keep a record of a person's contact details and appropriate information to enable us to comply with the request not to be contacted by us.

How we protect your information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of a persons' personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored by Sequence of Events Ltd.

We always ensure only authorised staff have access to a persons' information, and that they are appropriately trained to manage this data.

Sensitive and private data exchange between websites owned or controlled by Sequence of Events Ltd. and persons using those sites happens over a SSL secured communication channel and is encrypted and protected with digital signatures.

Despite all of our precautions, no data transmission over the internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. So, while we strive to protect personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of any information a person discloses to us online, and persons must understand that they do so at their own risk. However, any payment card details (such as credit or debit cards) we receive through our website are passed securely to our payment processing providers who meet the required Payment Card Industry (PCI) Security Standards (WorldPay) and we will never store card details

A Person's Rights

A person retains control of how we use their data and has the right to ask us to stop processing their personal information, which we will do.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which came into effect in the UK in May 2018, a person is also granted a number of additional rights. These include:

- The right to access their personal information – known as a subject access request
- The right to have their personal information that we no longer need erased from our records
- The right to have inaccurate personal information amended
- The right to ask us to stop using their information in certain situations
- The right to object to their personal information being used for marketing
- A right to have a copy of their personal information provided for reuse in another service

By using any services or websites owned or controlled by Sequence of Events Ltd. and/or by communicating with Sequence of Events Ltd. by phone, electronically and/or in person, a person signifies their acceptance of this policy. If a person does not agree to this policy, please do not use our services or websites or please do contact us to discuss further.
